			Determine patient BP by auscultation & report systolic/diastolic pressures found	Check for snug cuff fit/ brachial artery location/diaphragm of stethoscope used/slow deflation of cuff
			Determine patient BP by palpation & report systolic pressure found	Check for snug cuff fit/ radial artery location/diaphragm of stethoscope used/slow deflation of cuff
			Recognizes normal BP range	Adult 65-90 mmHg Child 50-80 mmHg
			Recognize appropriate treatment for a pt with low BP	Have pt lie down/elevate legs if not contraindicated (i.e. spinal injury concerns)
S – Satisfactory / P – Needs Prompting / U – Unsatisfactory
